Confession of Sin

Call to Confession (Romans 6:10-14)

For the death he (Jesus) died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

Corporate Confession

Father, we acknowledge that we do not consider ourselves dead to sin as we should. We too often allow various sins to reign in our mortal bodies and we often obey our earthly passions instead of your Word.
