





THE LORD’S TABLE

Harvest Community Church invites all those who know and love the Lord Jesus Christ, and who are baptized, communicant members in good standing, of a gospel-preaching church, to receive the Lord’s Supper with us. (Baptized children who have not yet become communicant members by a credible profession of faith should not participate in the Lord’s Supper.) We serve gluten-free bread. Grape juice (dark purple) is in the center rings of the trays marked by purple cups. Wine (light purple) is in the outside rings. Please hold the elements until all have been served, and then we will eat and drink together. If you are unable to come forward and need someone to bring you the elements, please raise your hand to get the attention of one of the elders serving the Supper.
