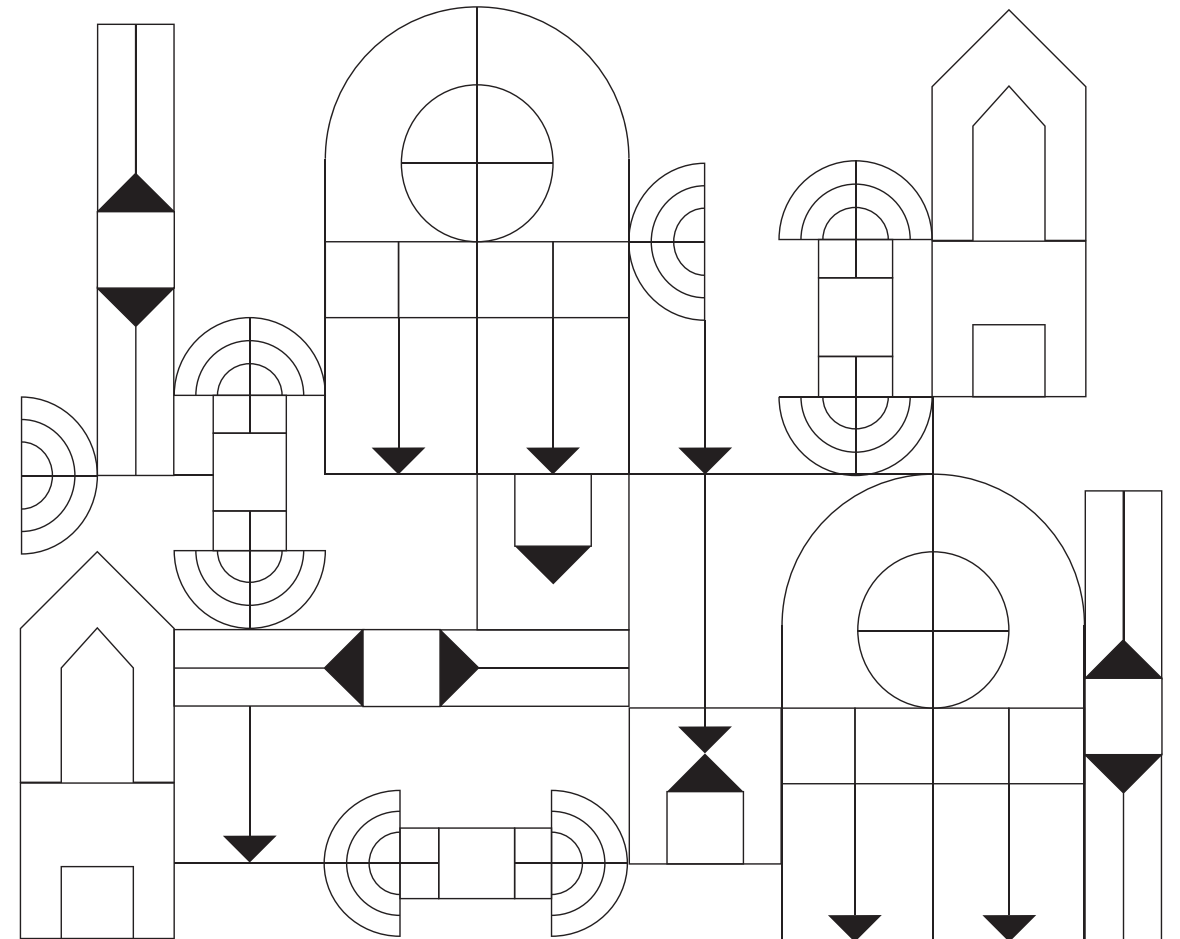

THE LORD'S TABLE
