WOMEN'S CRAFTIVITY

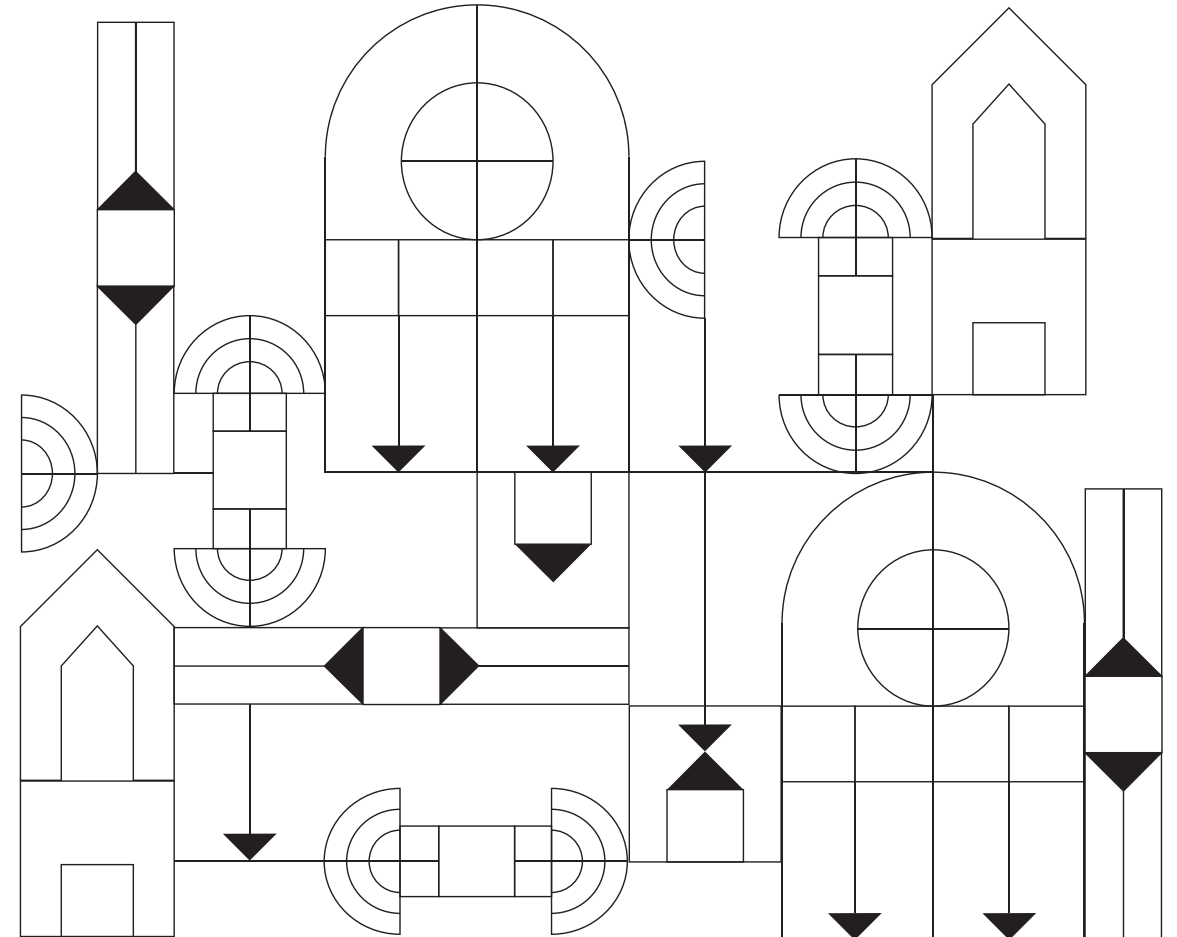
