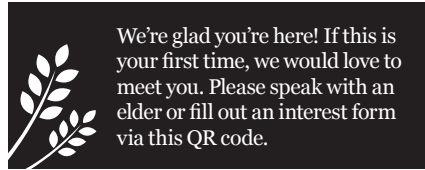

The men's Bible study will be studying Deuteronomy this summer. The men's Bible study meets on Friday mornings at 6:45AM.

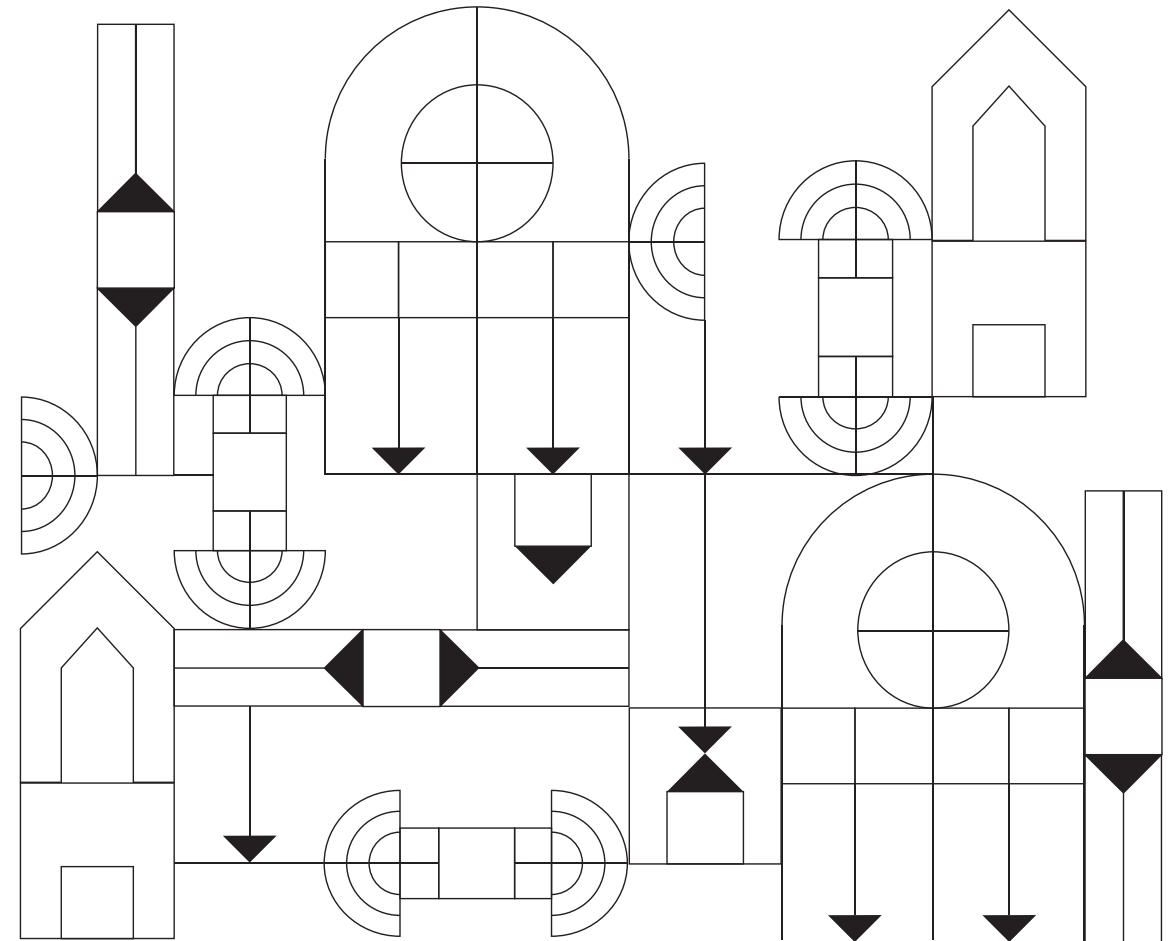

BENEDICTION
