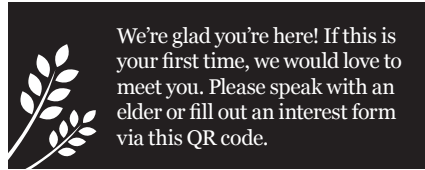

Sunday school is on summer break. Adult classes resume on May 31 and children's classes resume in August.

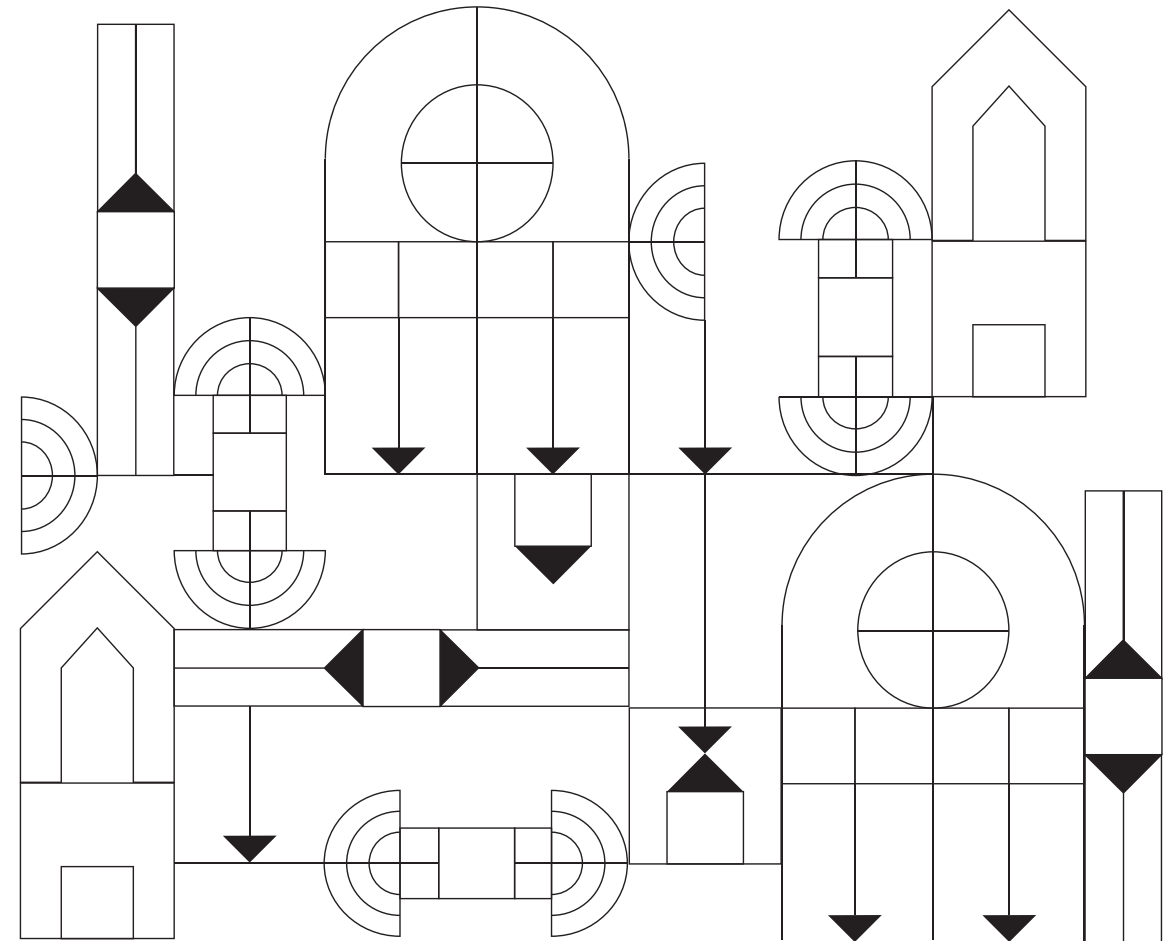
