We will hear Pastor Andrew's testimony today in the Fellowship Hall after the service.

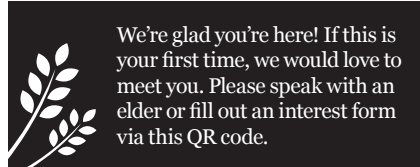
SUNDAY SCHOOL

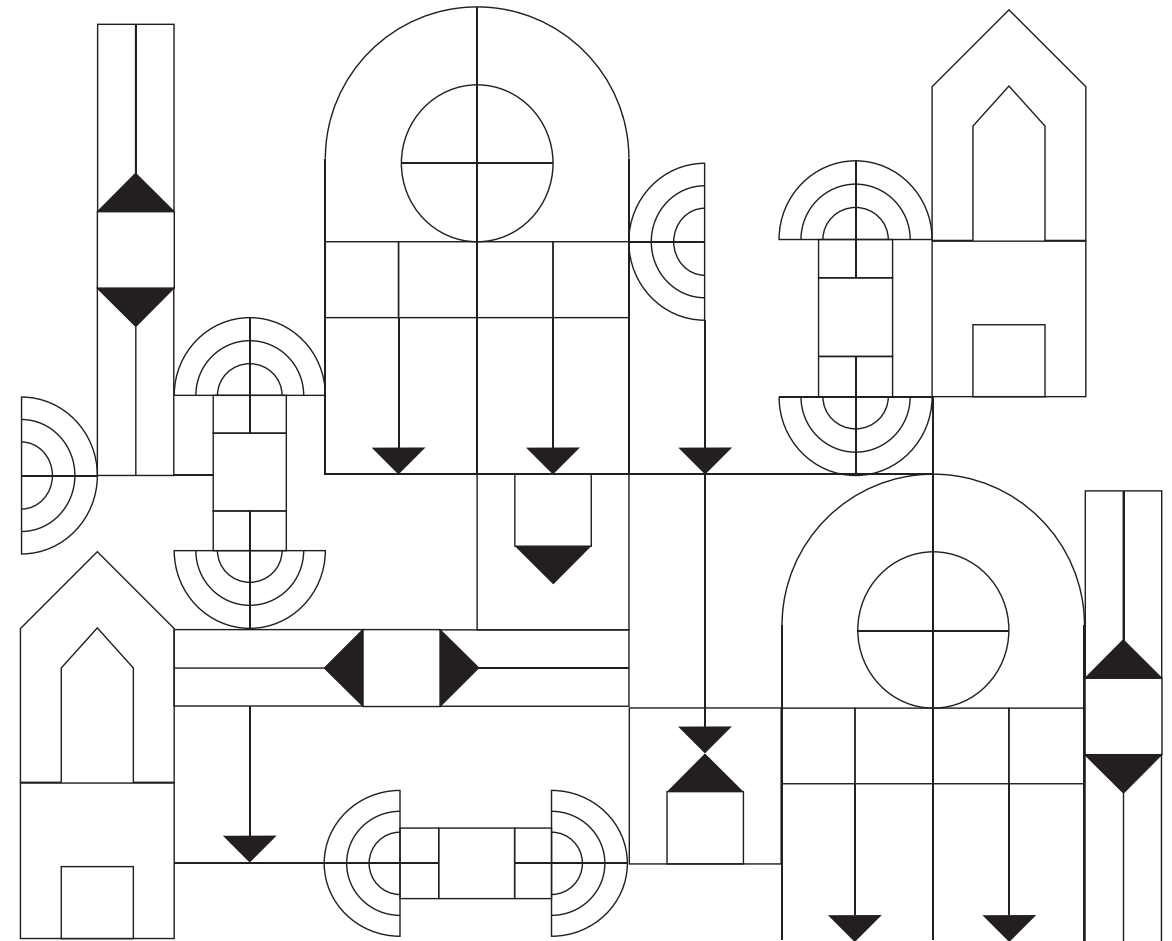

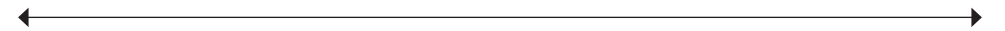

THE LORD'S TABLE

Harvest Community Church invites all those who know and love the Lord Jesus Christ and who are baptized, communicant members in good standing of a gospel-preaching church, to receive the Lord's Supper with us. If you are unable to come forward and need someone to bring you the elements, please raise your hand to get the attention of one of the elders serving the Supper.
