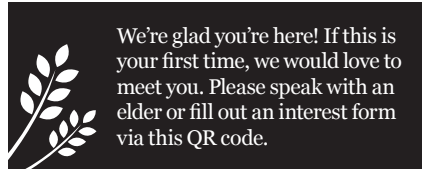

Please join us each Sunday morning this summer at 10:00 AM in Room 11 for a time of prayer before the worship service.

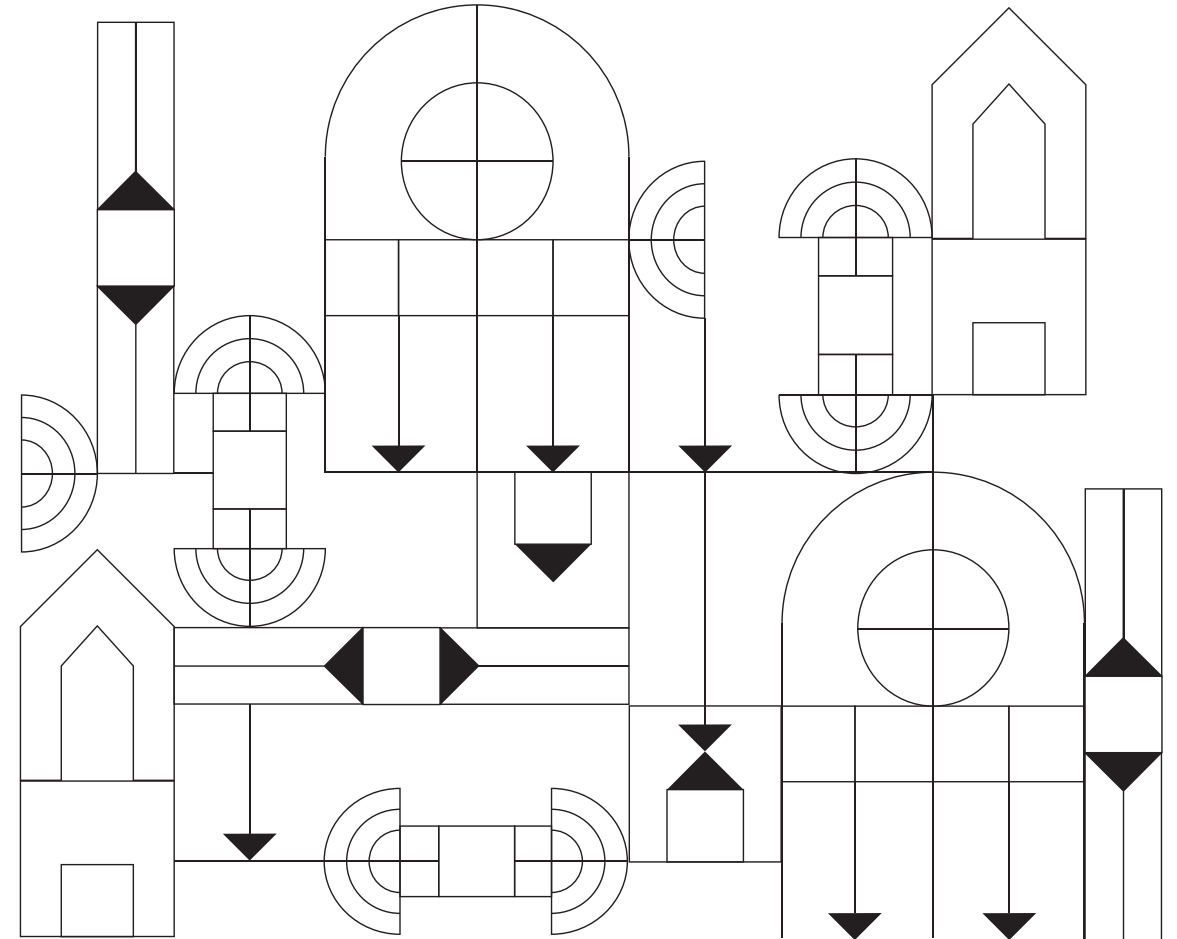
