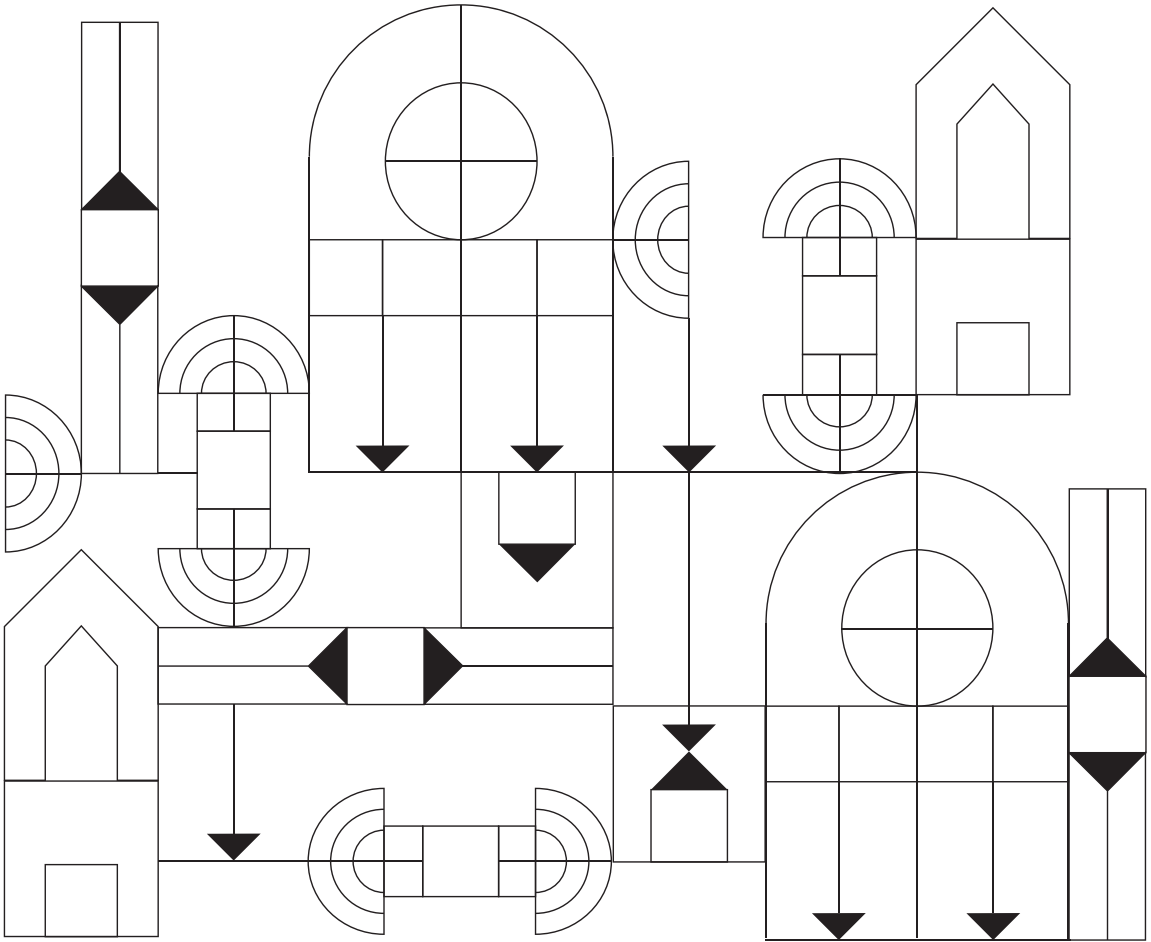
BABY SHOWER

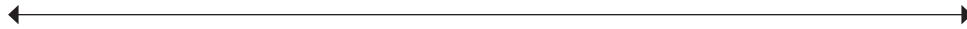
