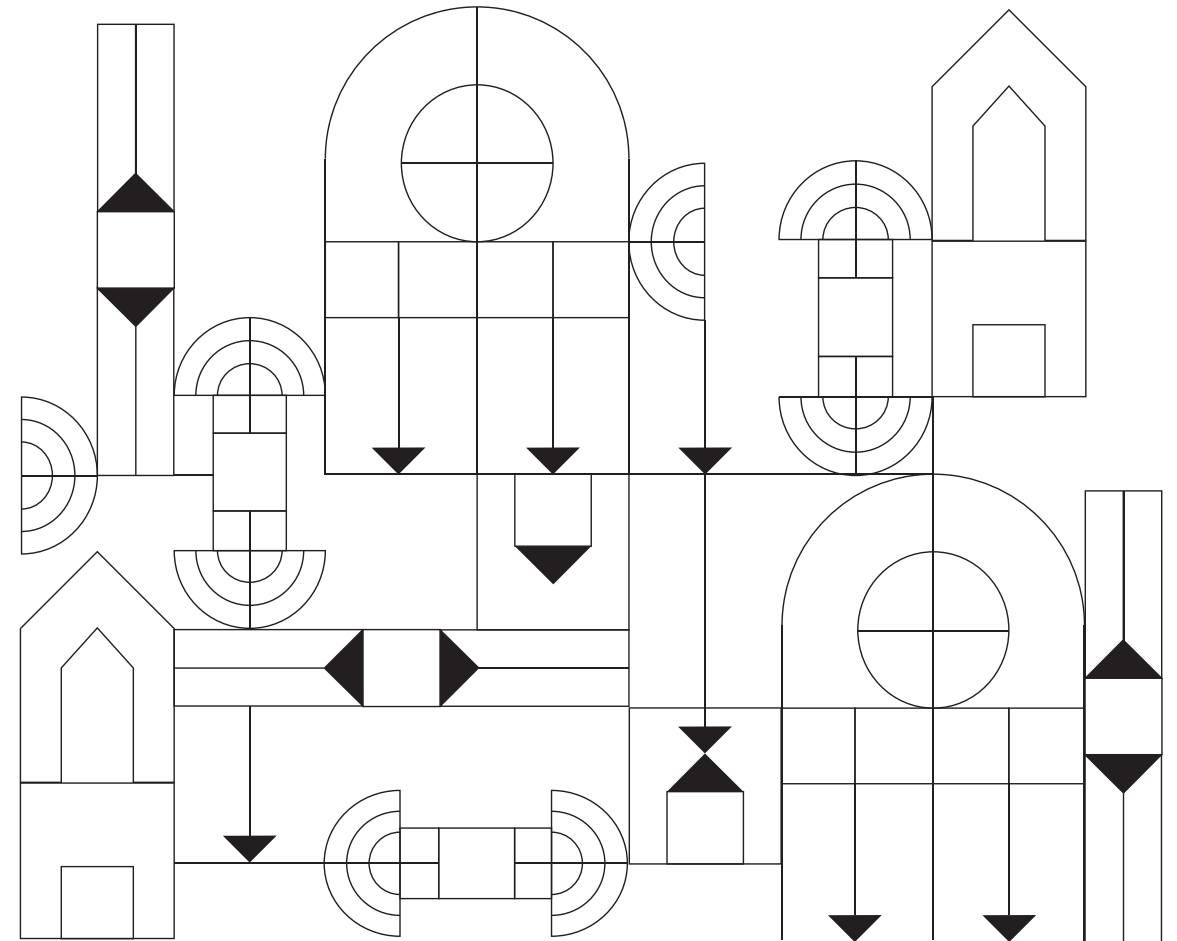

CALL TO WORSHIP: Psalm 135:1–5, 19–21
